#### **Kitchen Waste Receptacles**

Sorting procedures for waste receptacles in the kitchen.

Hello, all. There has been some confusion about how to dispose of things in the kitchen. Understandable, since we all come from different places with different rules. But we take our trash to the Transfer Station in Essex, so here's how they sort things:

Three types of recyclable items can be thrown out together: CANS, GLASS and recyclable PLASTICS (#'s 1, 2 and 5).. These they call COMMINGLED. We have one barrel for these three items.. Please be sure to first rinse them out before disposing.

Keep separate any and all kinds of PAPER. There is a barrel lined with a large paper leaf bag and marked paper. .

Also keep separate all CARDBOARD. Boxes can be folded up to fit into the barrel.

Anything else that isn't recyclable is TRASH and should be put into either of the two flip top metal trash cans that have plastic bag liners.

Finally, COMPOST. Minimal food waste, coffee grounds and compostable paper from coffee hour can go into black containers to the left of the sink. These are lined with special green compost bags found under the island. Thanks to Lacey for taking away the compost. Since Becky has an Essex transfer station sticker, she takes the trash and recyclables listed above. Many thanks to Will Holton for getting us some new barrels for the kitchen.
